

E'Governance Training for the ISG staff at World Bank

A training week was held at the e-gov group within ISG (Information Solutions Group) at the World Bank. The aim of the training week was to discuss and debate the issues involved in successful implementation of e-government projects at national and sub national levels. The participants consisted of the members of the e-government group within ISG at the World Bank. In all about 15 participants attended the training week. The training week was spread over four days. Each day had four sessions, with two sessions spread before and after the lunch break respectively. Thus, in all, sixteen sessions of training was conducted in four days. The sessions progressed from basic concepts of e-governance on the first day to ICT Project design, Designing Bank Projects and finally Operations and Supervision of projects on the last day of the training.

Senior consultants from GCS were involved in designing the content of the training week and delivering part of it to the ISG group. The development exercise included creation of training sessions, case studies and presentations. GCS consultants also delivered several of the training sessions to the ISG group at the World Bank.
