

Consulting assignment in Nepal

This assignment saw GCS consultants supporting the Nepal government on a water sector project.

The “Rural Water Supply & Sanitation Fund Development Board” (Fund Board) was set up by the Government of Nepal in 1996 to address the drinking water and sanitation needs of the rural poor of the Nepal. The “Rural Water Supply & Sanitation Project” was started under the Fund Board in 1996. This project throws up voluminous data pertaining to several rural water projects . The process of computerizing this data has been quite adhoc till now. An adhoc process of computerization has led to disparate systems developed using different HW and SW platforms.

GCS consultants helped consolidate the computerization process at the fund board. Upon specific recommendations of the GCS consultants, Nepal government decided to initiate a study to create an IT strategy for the board. This strategy document is expected to lead to initiation of an exercise of implementing an integrated IT solution for the functioning of the fund board in Nepal.
